Lesson resources - Scenarios: (To be cut out)

1. A girl in your class has hurt her ankle and can't play outside at lunchtime.
2. As you walk past the cloakroom, you see all the coats are on the floor.
3. A classmate has written a story that you think is really good.
4. At playtime, you see a group of children picking on a boy from your class. They are laughing at him and saying that he can't play with them.
5. You're rehearsing for the class assembly and your classmate keeps forgetting his lines.
6. A child in your class has been off school for two weeks because they've been unwell. Today is their first day back.
7. It's nearly the end of the day and the classroom is looking really untidy.
8. A new child arrives in your class. She has just moved from a different country and is learning English.
9. You are doing some painting in art. Your classmate has just finished his picture. As he stands up to go and show the teacher, he accidentally knocks over some water. The water goes all over his painting, your painting and the floor.
10. Your school is having a non-uniform day to raise money for charity. When you get to school, you see a child in your class who has forgotten that it is non-uniform day. They look upset.
11. Your friend tells you that she hasn't done her homework. She asks if she can copy yours.
12. During a maths lesson, the person sitting next to you is struggling with their work. They are getting frustrated and feeling stuck.
13. Your teacher says that you are going to be working in pairs. She tells you who you are working with. It is somebody you don't know very well.

17. During a basketball game in PE, your teammate falls over and hurts her foot. She has to sit out on the bench with an ice pack on her foot for the rest of the match.

18. You are asked to do a task in a small group. Some of the others in your group are finding it a bit tricky. You think it's really easy. You think you could do it all on your own and really quickly.

19. A boy in your class is worried because his dad is having an operation in the hospital today.

20. You notice that a boy in your class is feeling a bit lonely today because his best friend is away, and they usually do everything together.

21. At playtime, there is an unkind rumour going around about someone in your class. Everyone is talking about it.

22. A child in your class is writing something on the board. You see that they have made a spelling mistake. It's a word that you know how to spell.

23. A classmate solves a really difficult maths problem.

24. You're doing some group work in literacy. Your teacher has asked you to plan and rehearse a presentation for the class. You are feeling confident. One member of your group is feeling shy and having trouble reading their lines out loud.
