

A Special Gift

This is a lovely gift you can make for somebody you love. Perhaps you could give it to a parent, carer or sibling.

You will need: Scissors, glue, pens and pencils, cube template printed onto thin card if possible, ribbon or string.

* If you don't have a printer you can use any small cardboard box you might find at home such as one of the boxes tea bags come in. Carefully unstick the joins so that you have a template. Decorate the blank side of the template. Then fold the edges the opposite way and re-stick so that you have turned the box inside out.

*Be careful using scissors and ask for adult help if you need it.


Step 1:

Make your box

- 1. Decorate the cube template using coloured pens and pencils.
- 2. Cut out the cube template.
- 3. Fold along the lines.

You can use a ruler to help you fold in a straight line: put the ruler along the line and then fold the paper up against the ruler.

Fold the template into a cube shape:



- 4. Glue the **grey** tabs and then stick the tabs down inside the box.
- 5. Tie your piece of string or ribbon around the box (don't worry if you don't have any, this isn't the most important bit!)

Step 2:

Decorate or write the poem

Decorate the poem to make it look lovely and colourful.

Or copy the poem into your own handwriting and decorate it.

Step 3:

Give your gift!

Give the box and poem to somebody you love to show them how much you care.
