

At 52 Lives, we are committed to promoting the safety and wellbeing of every young person we work with. We also ensure the adults we work with are briefed in the correct behaviour expectations when working with children and young adults. While we are not physically present during virtual workshops, teachers and parents can be assured that all 52 Lives staff who work with children are DBS checked.

When participating in our virtual Kindness Workshops, we ask schools to follow their own safeguarding procedures. Please find below our Code of Conduct; all participants in our virtual Kindness Workshops must follow them in order to participate.

Code of Conduct

- We would encourage an adult to be present during the workshop.
- Children should be reminded about not sharing personal information during the workshop.
- Full names of the children should not be used during the workshop.
- Acceptable language should always be used by all participants.
- Any recordings or photos taken of our workshop should only be shared with the permission of 52 Lives.
- If we are concerned about the welfare of a child, we may need to let someone know (as per our Child Safeguarding Policy, which can be <u>found here</u>).
