DAY 1: BE A WASTE DETECTIVE

Recycling is brilliant – but do you know what's even better? Using less in the first place! Today, have a look around your home or school. Can you see anything that is a 'single use' item (these are things that are used once and thrown away, such as straws, wrapping paper or cling film.) Are there any toys you bought that you haven't really played with? Is there any food in your fridge that has gone bad before you could eat it?

Noticing these things helps us to be aware of what we buy and to cut back on waste. Buying less can also help us to appreciate the things we have, which is not only good for the environment, it's also better for our well-being as well. Think about using your own scrap paper instead of printing this activity sheet.
